A Message From Lyla

We have been working as much as possible on the crop coming up. The first day we could rent the building was June 11th. It is my hope that this will be successful and become an annual event! My goal is to raise \$1200 to \$1500 for the club. I am working on sponsorships at this time to pay for the building rent. I am asking for a minimum amount of \$50 up to anything they would like to give. If anyone knows of someone they think would be willing to sponsor please let me (321-2130) or Mattie Crawford (321-2120) know and we will get them a sponsor form and get them signed up.

We are planning on having shirts with the name of the crop on the front and our sponsors on the back. We are also going to be offering goodie bags to each participant. We are working on what to fill the bags with at this time. We also have a really cute owl bag to put these goodies in.

Each vendor will be asked to pay \$50 for their spot and be asked to donate some of their stuff for a door prize. Everything they make will be their profit but if they would like to donate a certain portion of their sales that would be great. There is an option for this on the vendor form.

I am working with Angie Smith to get flyers made up and an on-line form for people to start signing up. Everyone will have to sign up and pay in advance. We are thinking about offering a gift certificate to the one referring and bringing the most people with them. Once we get it posted on social media we will be asking everyone in the club to share with all of their friends so we can get the word out. I have a commitment from Springfield girls, Harrison girls, Norfolk girls, and several local girls that will attend. We are also considering opening it up for outsiders to come in and shop at the vendor booths; however, we are not sure about that yet.

The club will be asked to bring in sandwiches and such for lunch and potluck for supper. The participants fee will include the cost of two meals, their goodie bags, door prizes, and their shirts. Each participant will have their own table and I am in hopes that we can use the fairgrounds tables.

There will be lots of preparations to be made before the crop so I will need a lot of help making up things to be used. I need a volunteer to oversee the kitchen and food prep. I will also need greeters, runners, an Emcee, and people to set up and take down tables and chairs. The fairground does the clean up after we have everything out of the building.

On a different note.....

Since we came in second place last year with our scrapbook, I would like to try and top that this year! That would mean I need more input from all of you, including any pictures, comments, documents, ideas for journaling, ect. To tell our story I need everybody's input. Even though you might think it is too minor or not what is needed, give it to me and let me see if I can use it. You might just be surprised! Even if it is just an idea, I might use it! Journaling is one of the hardest parts, so if you have pictures please write the dates on them and what is going on in them. This makes my job so much easier.
